## Please note the following recommendations to ensure a pest-free environment:

- Please do not bring personal food items, which you intend on **not** consuming immediately, into Resident living areas.

  - o Please avoid "storing" food in the Resident closets or bedside tables.

- Please ensure that no cardboard boxes are left on the floor in Resident's rooms and closets.
