Are your IMMUNIZATIONS up to date?

- As a Health Care worker, you are responsible to **CONFIRM** that your immunizations are up to date to ensure you are protected against vaccine preventable diseases. This helps keep you, our patients and other worker healthy!
- Guidelines have changed over the last number of years, so you may require some immunizations or blood work to ensure you are immune.
- **KNOW** not **ASSUME** that you are **IMMUNE** to the following:
 - Measles, Mumps, Rubella
 - Varicella (Chickenpox)
 - Hepatitis B

AND

- Know your Tetanus/Diphtheria is current (last 10 years)
- Know your Pertussis (Whooping Cough) is current (1 dose since age 18)
- Know your COVID and Influenza is current (1 dose since Oct. 10, 2023)
